Day 1 - Legal Considerations for South Carolina Code Officials – 6 hours

Being a code official can be difficult and full of legalese. This course is designed to assist code officials in becoming better acquainted with the duties and legal responsibilities of enforcing South Carolina Code of Laws pertaining to code enforcement and the ICC adopted codes and referenced standards. Additionally, this course serves as a refresher for those preparing to take the ICC Legal Module of the ICC Certified Building Official or Certified Fire Marshal examinations in reference to the 2017 Legal Aspects of Code Administration Reference.

Day 2 – “Michelin Cuisine” – A complete review of the 2018 IFC and referenced standards pertaining to mobile cuisine – 6 hours

Not to be confused with Michelin Star restaurants, this course is designed to assist fire code officials with the deliciousness that rolls in on Michelins into your jurisdictions. Mobile food preparation vehicles have been gaining popularity in recent years, and until recently, there were no codes or standards to provide minimum fire safety requirements. This course will give South Carolina Fire Code Officials the knowledge to apply the 2018 IFC and 2017 edition of NFPA 96 and NFPA 58 relating to these fine dining options.

Day 3 – “1.3G and 1.4G Firework Displays” – A complete overview of the 2018 IFC and referenced standard requirements for outdoor and indoor firework displays. - 6 hours

With July 4th around the corner, this course is designed to assist fire code officials with ensuring public safety during these amazing indoor and outdoor pyrotechnic displays. This course includes a hands-on site inspection and a Live Display at 2100 hrs. (weather permitting).

Day 4 – Overview and Update of Fire Safe SC / Fire Safe SC Home Safety Visit Train-the-Trainer - 3 hours

Fire Safe SC was first announced at the SC Fire Marshals Association’s Spring Conference in 2017. During this session, an update on the progress of Phase 1 of Fire Safe SC and an introduction to Phase 2 of Fire Safe SC will be provided. As a part of Fire Safe SC Phase 2, participating fire departments who desire to earn the Fire Safe SC designation, will be challenged to conduct home safety visits in their communities. The Fire Safe SC Home Safety Visit Train-the-Trainer will provide the learner with the knowledge and resources needed to implement home safety visits in their community.
